General Information

- ✦ No candidate shall be eligible for admission after a lapse of more than three years from the year of passing the previous qualifying examination. The year of admission will not be taken into account while calculating 3 years from the year of passing the previous qualifying examination.
- ✦ A student must have studied and passed in English in the +2 level. (excluding the foreign students for whom there is a separate set of rules).
- ✦ Admission will be given on the basis of the marks of the Admission Test. However, the student must pass Plus Two examination conducted by a recognised Board/Council in India and obtain a minimum of 55% marks in the aggregate and also minimum 45% marks in each of the four subjects (as mentioned in the eligibility criteria) included in the aggregate calculation. During the admission procedure if it is found that a candidate is selected on the basis of admission test but fails to fulfill the minimum marks criteria as mentioned above then the admission of the candidate will be cancelled.
- ✦ The final Plus Two result must be submitted to the University at the time of admission.
