All the students with **Arrear Papers (Theory/Practical)** from Odd Semester are hereby advised to fill up examination forms through online mode available on the University website (www.sxuk.edu.in) through student's login from **February 12, 2025 (Wednesday)** to **February 18, 2025 (Tuesday)**. The fees for the Arrear Examinations without late payment is **INR 750/-** per Paper (Theory / Practical).

The examination forms will also be accepted from the students from **February 19, 2025 (Wednesday)** to **February 25, 2025 (Tuesday)** for Arrear Examinations with late payment i.e., **INR 1500/-** per paper (Theory / Practical). No application for 'Arrear Examinations' will be entertained thereafter under any circumstances.

The students can download their **Admit Cards** from the University website (www.sxuk.edu.in) through student's login on and from **March 05, 2025 (Wednesday)** at 04.00 PM. Entry into the Examination Hall will be allowed only on production of Admit Card along with Student's ID Card. The students are instructed to report the Examination Hall 15 minutes prior to the scheduled starting of examinations.

Important Rules for the Examinations:

- 1) Entry into the Examination Hall will be allowed only on production of Admit Card along with Student's ID Card.
- 2) The students are instructed to report the Examination Hall 15 minutes before the scheduled starting of examinations.
- 3) No entry will be allowed 15 minutes after the commencement of examination without the written permission of Controller of Examinations. But any such permission will be given only during the first 30 minutes after commencement of the examination.
- 4) No student will be permitted to submit the answer script before the completion of the first hour of the examination.
- 5) Temporary exit will not be permitted before one hour from the commencement of the examination.
- 6) No student will be allowed to keep mobile phone in his/her possession or any other electronic device (except calculator, if permitted) during the time of examination.
- 7) Instructions on the Admit Card/Answer booklet and other related examination rules are to be strictly followed.
- 8) You must write the Question Number (Q. No.) you are answering, otherwise the answer may be cancelled.
- 9) Do all rough work in the Answer Book and cross it through. No loose sheet will be provided for scribbling, and no paper is to be brought in for this purpose. Any candidate possessing loose paper or found copying will be subject to Disciplinary Action under the relevant rules.
- 10) If you use any additional loose sheet(s), graph papers etc., tie it / them up firmly with this answer book. Do not write answers on the loose sheets until you have used all the pages in the answer book.
- 11) You have to write your Roll No. and Registration No. in the space provided for the purpose and nowhere else. Do not disclose your identity in any other manner. Do not write your name in any part of the answer book, loose sheet(s), graph paper(s) (if any), etc. Your answer book will be cancelled for violation of any above-mentioned instructions (point no. 11).**
