

SKILL ENHANCEMENT SESSIONS

The students of XBS are exposed to several skill enhancement sessions making them industry-ready. Before formal the classes started. students underwent a rigorous team building activity, conducted by Team Builders India Private Limited, lead by Mr. Utsav Shukla. The sessions were conducted online, and it brought the students to learn a core essence of professional life - working in a team. Over the course of the first semester, the batch were additionally taught skills to enhance their communication and spreadsheet softwares.

Advanced Excel Course by DataSkills, conducted by Mr. Kartik Dale, a certified Microsoft trainer in Excel. The students learnt the basics such as sorting and advanced functions such as vlookup and hlookup. The soft skills classes were carried out by the founder of the Sunflower Community, Ms. Anmol Sehgal, which was critical to students learning the basic etiquettes of corporate setup, such as grooming, social media behaviour, and resume building. The second semester included soft skills training by Dr. Faizal and team. The batch was further made aware of the modern data visualization tools, namely Tableau, which was taught by Professor Karnak Roy of the Administrative Staff College of India.



COURSE STRUCTURE

MBA offered by Xavier Business School (XBS) is a Two-Year Degree programme with three areas of specialization offered–Marketing, Finance and Human Resources. The entire course covers 20 obligatory management subjects (OMC). The Specialized Subjects (Electives) are according to one's choice, and each student has to choose 8 such Specialized Subjects (SPL). Besides, there are 4 Additional Requirements (ARQ): Project Work, which has to be carried out during summer holidays, Comprehensive Viva, at the end of second and fourth semesters, Dissertation, and Extra-Curricular Activities and programmes. Every student is expected to be actively involved in Extra-Curricular Activities and programmes organized by XBS and also by the University itself and he/she is assessed for his/her participation and performance in these Extra-Curricular activities.






